You will be continually assessed through practical assignments throughout the course, and some on-line tests. In this year you will focus on the practical elements of removing and fitting replacement parts with a focus on:

- Workshop safety
- Cooling & lubrication systems
- Fuel & ignition systems
- Electrical & electronic systems
- Engine systems
- Braking systems
